Notification from Arizona Fish and Game and Urban Wildlife: Residents are advised to avoid the courtyard entrance to AFC due to a hawk protecting its nest in the tree opposite the courtyard. It is important for our community to respect the wildlife and give them the necessary space during this temporary situation.

We will be replacing the chaise loungers at the Aquatic & Fitness Center (AFC) and the Desert Oasis (DO) due to wear and tear. As a result, we are selling the pool chaise loungers at the AFC for \$45, and the discolored chaise loungers at the DO for \$20. Please come to the Welcome Center to pay for these items and get a paid voucher. Between Thursday, May 23, and Wednesday, May 29, take your voucher to either the AFC or DO to pick up your furniture. These items are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Remember to bring assistance for loading the furniture into your vehicle.

The gym will be closed Monday, May 20, for installation of new treadmills, cross-trainers, recumbent and upright bikes. Stop in and see all the new features of the new equipment. The pool will have normal hours.

Change to canceling lane reservations: It is important to cancel reserved lanes that you aren't going to use. Three uncanceled reservations will result in a two-week suspension from reserving lanes. Beginning June 1st, monitors will no longer cancel lanes for residents within an hour of their start time. You must cancel your lane prior to an hour before the start of your reservation.

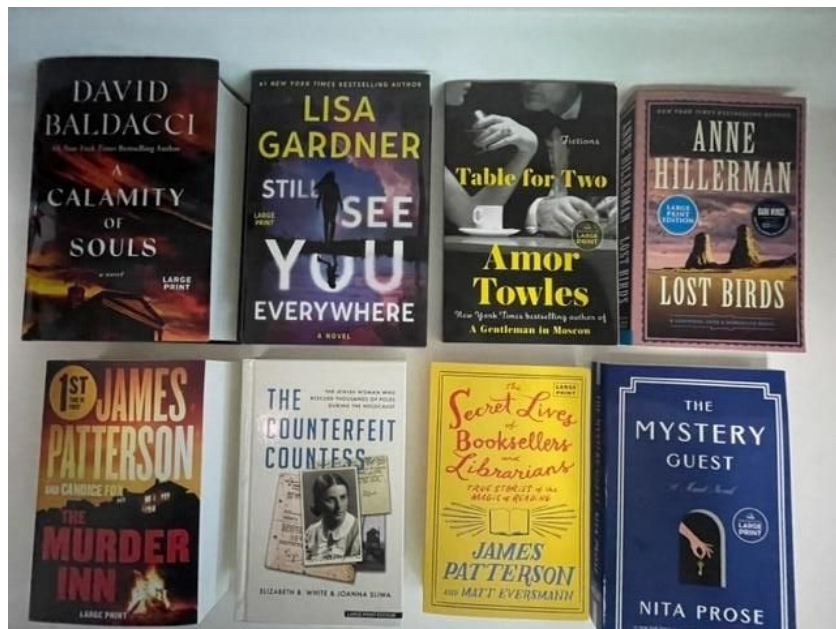
