**Republic Services:** Calling Republic's customer service does not work because you don't have an account with them; SCOV has the account. In the members-only section on our website under Member Services, scroll down and click on the picture of the blue trash bin. Here you will find the online form to submit requests directly to the department that handles the SCOV account. New bin orders, exchanges, and missed pickups are processed this way.

**Did you know?** In 2013, visionary residents voted to approve our current Aquatic Fitness Center (AFC). It required a \$385 assessment per household, the last one we've had. The old "gym" was packed with 5 treadmills, 4 bikes, 3 ellipticals, 6 Life Fitness machines, some free weights, a TV with rabbit ears, and small locker rooms. Our current AFC boasts free wi-fi, more machines, including new cardio equipment, free weights, a larger exercise area, a large exercise studio, and beautiful locker rooms.
