Copper Center Renovation Task Force meeting on Wednesday, July 3, is canceled. The Architectural Team has met with all Copper Center Stakeholders to begin the development of space and room layouts. All existing spaces were photographed/recorded for use in developing new layouts. Preliminary layouts and updates are anticipated after the July 4 holiday.

 Turn left on Sun City Blvd, then left on Biltmore, loop around to Rancho Vistoso
 Cross Rancho Vistoso to Sun City Blvd, then left on Alamo Canyon Dr
 Right on Summerstar Blvd
 Left on Sun City Blvd
 Right on Lost Arrow Dr, turn left on Del Webb
 Left on Ruella, right on Chrysanthemum
 Left on Del Webb, then left on Cargandera Canyon Dr to Lobelia, then right on Bighorn Mt Dr
 Left on Del Webb Blvd, then right on Engle Hill Dr
 Left on Somnolent Wy to Mellow Trl, then left on Trade Winds Wy
 Right on Silkwood, then left on Del Webb Blvd
 Turn left on Bright Angel Dr, then left on Crown Point Dr
 Turn left on Copperstone Dr, then right on Silverton to Mountain Vista Recreation Center parking lot (parade start point)
