Association News

We are expanding the SCOV Community Directory Committee to make recommendations for resuming the printed directory and doing hands-on work (with SCOV staff) to make that happen by October 2024. Did you know? In 1988, three residents started our library in the Gift Shop with 35 paperbacks and a set of cookbooks. In the early years, it moved to a shared space with the Billiards Club, then to the Weight Room, and on to the Desert Oasis. In 2001, it moved to its current location and as one of our most popular amenities, it now offers around 15,000 items.

As a reminder to all residents, according to current SCOV Development Standards, Section 2.5, and the 1st Amended Master Declaration, Section 4.9, "Trash containers may be stored on the lot as to be not visible from neighboring property or street. If trash/recycle containers cannot be stored to be not visible from neighboring property or street, then containers must be stored in the garage. In no event shall such containers be maintained to be visible from neighboring property, except when made available for collection, and then for the shortest time reasonably necessary to affect such collection."
