**The Board has received an update** from the Copper Center Task Force and wants to share it with you. An architectural team has been selected to complete the Schematic Design per BOD approved layout and budget. They have finished documenting and comparing the existing floor plans (as-builts) of the current spaces and have begun to lay out individual spaces for each of the stakeholders. Within the next few weeks, the architectural team will present plans and layouts to the Copper Center Renovation Task Force (CCRTF) and stakeholders for final review before finalizing the schematic design package and cost estimate. As the progress continues, the Copper Center Renovation Task Force will provide additional status reports via "This Week in SCOV".
