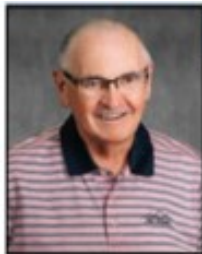

Did you know? On May 21, 1986, Del Webb hosted around 200 politicians, businesspeople, and guests for the groundbreaking ceremony for Sun City Vistoso. Off Oracle Road, they turned onto a dirt construction road and crossed the Big Wash (there was no bridge) to arrive at our 1,000-acre site. The original plans called for 2,900 homes for the \$250 million project. Today, we're built out at 2,488 homes.
