**What exactly is a hedge?** A hedge is essentially a fence or barrier created by a row of closely planted shrubs, serving a purpose similar to that of a screen, wall, or traditional fence. According to our guidelines, any hedge within your yard—whether in the front, back, or side—should not exceed six feet in height. It is advisable to

keep it trimmed even shorter to allow for healthy growth before the next trimming is necessary. Please check your yard to ensure your hedge meets these requirements
