Don't Feed Wildlife: It has come to our attention that some residents have been feeding wildlife. Feeding wildlife is not healthy for the animals and often leads to property damage and safety issues for people and pets. Most wildlife attacks are a result of fed wildlife becoming too habituated to humans. Feeding and attracting wildlife (except birds and tree squirrels) is illegal in PIMA County and violations can result in up to a \$300 fine.
