Member Vote – May 2025. The Board of Directors has called for a membership vote on three important initiatives: 1) authorization to spend funds; 2) a special assessment for amenity improvement, including the Copper Center, and 3) a change to the Capital Contribution Fee multiplier. To provide information and answer questions about these initiatives, two forums will be held on Monday, April 28, at 11 am and 6 pm, Activity Center/ Auditorium. If you are unable to attend or wish to review the materials at your convenience, the same information, including a video presentation and a sample ballot, will be available on the Vote May 2025 webpage by the end of the day on Tuesday, April 29. Ballots will be distributed on Tuesday, April 29. If you have an email address on file, your ballot will be emailed. For the 48 lots without emails on record, a paper ballot will be sent via USPS. If you would prefer a paper ballot, you may pick one up at the Administration Office starting Tuesday afternoon. Voting closes at 6 am on Tuesday, May 27. Results will be emailed to the membership and announced at the Board meeting.
