Association News

Catalina Vista Patio Replacement begins tomorrow and is expected to continue through approximately July 24. During the demolition phase, residents should anticipate increased construction noise in the area. A portion of the parking lot will be cordoned off for material storage, including sand and pavers. Please use caution around the work zone. Thank you for your patience as we complete this improvement.

Pool & Spa Project Update – Work continues on the newly permitted heater vent connections. Once complete, Southwest Gas will upgrade the gas meter, after which the new heaters will be connected, commissioned, and placed into service. Daily pool cleaning and opening procedures have largely returned to normal. At Desert Oasis, we are conducting a trial 6:30 am. opening through the end of July to determine whether cleaning and maintenance can be completed while providing residents with additional morning swim time. Desert Oasis pool hours are Monday - Friday 6:30 am - 8:30 pm, Saturday - 6:30 am - 7:30 pm, Sunday - 6:30 am - 5:30 pm.

A friendly reminder that the AFC pool will be closed at 4:30 pm on Saturday, July 4. Have a Happy Independence Day.

With many homeowners taking early morning strolls, it's important to keep safety in mind regarding our sidewalks, which are legally required to be used. First, if you have cacti or bushes that encroach upon the sidewalk, please ensure they are trimmed back to prevent any injuries to pedestrians. Additionally, if you have palm trees with dead fronds, it's crucial to remove them to avoid the risk of these fronds becoming projectiles during the strong winds of the monsoon season, potentially endangering both walkers and vehicles.

Golf Cart Parking: Throughout our community, there are designated golf cart parking spaces that are shorter in length and are specifically designed for golf carts. Please refrain from parking automobiles in these spaces, as they are reserved exclusively for golf carts. This does not include 'dual use' spaces, which can be used for both.



Motorized Scooters and Sidewalk Safety - We recently received a report of a motorized scooter traveling at a high rate of speed on a sidewalk, causing a resident walking their dog to step aside. As a reminder, sidewalks are intended for pedestrians. In Oro Valley, motorized scooters are generally not permitted on public sidewalks and are instead allowed on local streets, bicycle lanes, and designated multi-use paths such as the Chuck Huckelberry Loop. When your grandkids are visiting, help keep our community safe by ensuring scooters are operated in appropriate areas and with consideration for others.

New ARC & In-House Permits The ARC is implementing a new process to alert residents to projects that have Association approval. Beginning July 1, a yellow permit will be issued to owners upon an In-House or ARC approval made after July 1. The Project Approval Permit can be picked up at the Welcome Center after July 1. After receiving an approval for a project, this permit must be displayed in a front window visible from the street until project completion. 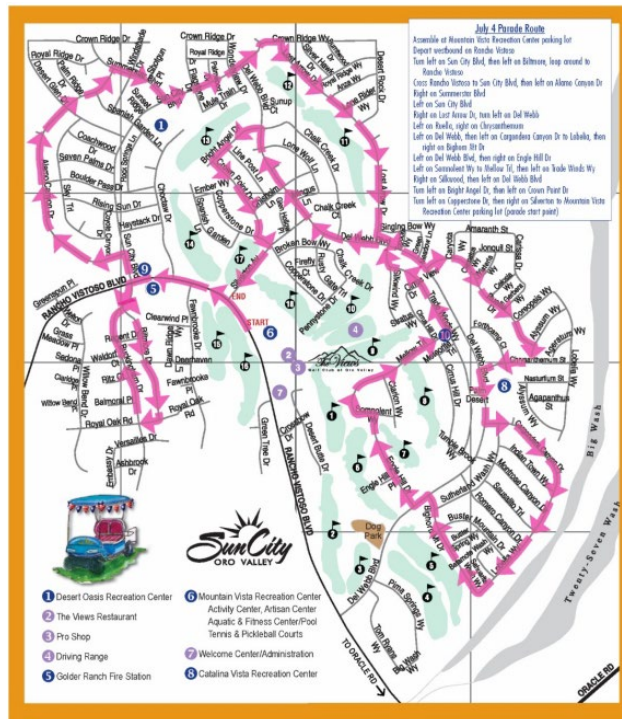
