What are the Exterior Lighting Rules? As you are aware, in May of this year, the Board approved recommendations from the ARC regarding changes to the Development Standards. One of those changes involved exterior lighting and how Pima County and the Town of Oro Valley's Dark Skies outdoor lighting code figures into our governing documents. Please take the time to read the Development Standards Section 2.7 Exterior Lighting, which has been rewritten to make it much clearer to residents who were confused by previous lighting instructions. Also, remember that our Master Declaration Section 4.5 states: "No lighting shall be permitted which causes unreasonable glare to neighboring property owners, neighborhoods, or common area." Development Standards Section 2.7.E.8.a further supports this to state: "Accent and Spot lighting used to highlight plants or other features of the property must not be pointed higher than 45 degrees above horizontal and must not be pointed toward neighboring properties."
