## Help Us Plan "40 and Fabulous"

**In the fall of 2026, SCOV turns 40 years old!** The Board of Directors has approved a special committee to plan and coordinate a month-long celebration of all things Sun City Oro Valley. At this time, we envision multiple sports tournaments, talent performances, an artisan show and so much more. And the celebration will conclude with a formal dinner and dance.

The "Forty and Fabulous" SCOV 40th Anniversary Celebration is an initiative developed by the Supplemental Revenue Stream Task Force. This month-long event invites all clubs to participate, with support from the Anniversary Committees, by organizing activities that will raise funds for their respective treasuries.

Examples of potential events include a tournament hosted by the Pickleball Club, collaborative gatherings organized by the Golf Leagues, and an art competition. In addition to club-specific programs, there will be fundraising activities dedicated to supporting the Capital Fund.

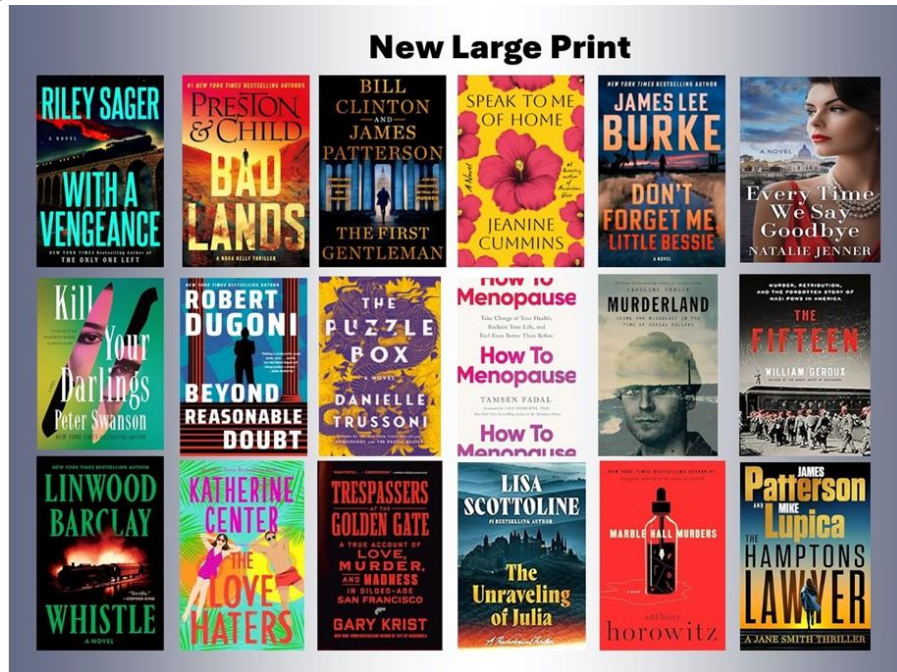
